

Eligibility Criteria

Who can apply?

To be eligible to apply for a grant, your group must be one of the following:

- A registered charity
- A voluntary or community organisation
- A not-for-profit company
- A community interest company (CIC)
- A charity incorporated organisation (CIO)
- A school
- A statutory body
- An unincorporated club or association
- A community benefit society
- A group requesting financial donations must have a business bank account. Financial donations cannot be paid to an individual.
- Employees and relatives of employees of British Gypsum may apply for a grant.
- Resident of our local community, within a 15 minute drive time of one of our 5 manufacturing sites.

What can we support?

- Local projects within a 15 mile drive time of one of our 5 manufacturing sites.
- Projects that benefit your local community, particularly the priority issues British Gypsum are working to make a difference on:
 - o Supporting young people, including those from diverse backgrounds to access science, technology, engineering and mathematics education and careers
 - o Poverty and inclusion and diversity in and around our site locations
